**Who:**

**Students may attend the fair:**

- with their class
- with their parents on Friday, March 26 from 3:00-5:00 pm for the Love-of-Books Adult & Child Shopping Extravaganza
- during breaks in schedule and recess for upper school boys

**Adults in the CSB community may attend the fair on Friday, March 26:**

- immediately after Hymn Sing for the Blissfully Quieter Adult Shopping from 9:00-11:00 am
- with their children/relatives and friends for the Love-of-Books Adult & Child Shopping Extravaganza from 3:00-5:00 pm
- at the Finally an Adult Only Cocktail Party! from 5:00-7:00 pm (Free care provided for CSB students and siblings ages 5-11 only between 5-7 pm while parents attend the Finally an Adult Only Cocktail Party! Children must be signed up in advance. Download the Child Care Reservation Form (due Tuesday, March 23) from the CSB website.

### **How:**

**Payment Options: For materials purchased before Friday, March 26 students may pay by:**

- returning a completed and signed credit card form to their homeroom teacher
- enclosing cash in a sealed envelope with the student's first and last name printed on the front and given to their home room teacher (optional for upper school)

**For materials purchased on Friday, March 26, adults may add check payment (payable to CSB) as an option**

### **What:**

#### **You will experience:**

- fiction and non-fiction books for the CSB community including preschool, elementary, middle school and adult reads for entertainment, information and edification
- posters and the fabulously popular school supplies cart
- white wine, sparkling water and appetizers including recipes from this year's featured cookbook *The Spice Kitchen: Everyday Cooking with Organic Spices* during the Finally an Adult Only Cocktail Party!
- light snacks for children signed up for Day Care from 5-7 pm
- an intentional lack of software, electronics, toys (except for a small handful of educational wooden offerings) and deliberate avoidance of most TV/movie tie-in/cheater code type books

### **What:**

#### **The Teacher Wish List:**

- allows CSB faculty and staff to select desired books from the fair and indicate on the Wish List slip if the book will be for classroom or personal use
- books all receive a Book Plate Sticker, which may be dedicated and signed for the chosen staff/faculty member
- slips are housed on a tri-fold board in the library staffed with a helpful wish list volunteer
- slips indicate the location of book fair materials. These locations include table, cart or rounder. Stop by and have it all make sense.

### **What:**

#### **The Student Wish Lists:**

- are completed in preparation for adults shopping without their child(ren). Each student will complete a 3-4 item "wish list" when they visit with their class.
- will be filed alphabetically by student name and class for easy adult access during the Blissfully Quieter Adult Shopping and Finally an Adult Only Cocktail Party! on Friday, March 26
